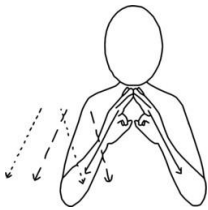

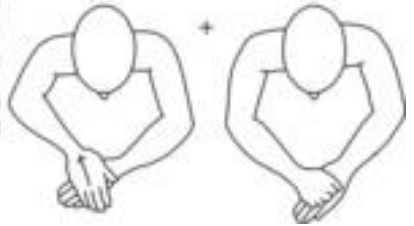

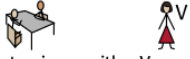

the  Church  were  then  given the opportunity to  fill  boxes back at





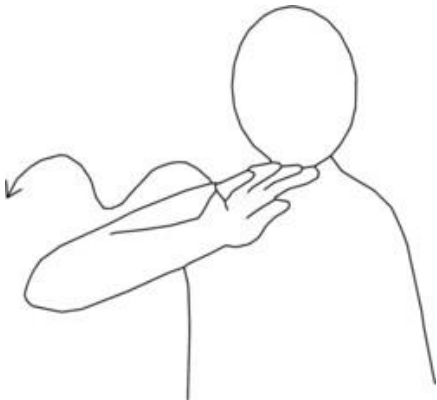
